OPENING DAY

CEREMONY: Opening Ceremony will begin 7:00pm Monday evening. Each team should be in uniform and bring a State Flag and/or Team Banner. All teams must be lined up and ready by 6:30 pm. More details on opening ceremonies will be posted at a later date.

AWARDS: 1st – 4th Place – Individual Trophies

UNIFORMS: All players and coaches must comply with IFA rules.

DISTANCE:* 40 feet

GAMES: 5 game guarantee

GAME BALL: 12" .47 Core Worth Optic Yellow. Game Balls will be provided for the entire Tournament.

**ALL HELMETS MUST HAVE A FACEMASK
AND CHIN STRAP**
NO exceptions!

Steel Cleats will NOT be permitted

WARM UP: There are designated warm up areas behind the green temporary fences. Under no circumstances will any warm up be allowed in any area where spectators are. This rule will be strictly enforced. May have batting practice in designated areas with plastic balls or hit sticks. No peppering against any fence, No climbing fences to retrieve balls – chain links or temporary outfield fence.

INFIELD PRACTICE: Teams may warm up on the grass while infield is being prepared. No infield practice on newly prepared fields. Unused fields may be used for practice. Please check with a Mustang Softball Assoc. representative before using.

DUGOUT: Maximum allowed in dugout is 22. 2 coaches, 1 bat person, 18 players. All other unauthorized personnel will be asked to leave.

PROTEST: Please study the rules, appeals and protest procedures. All protests will be handled by the Tournament Committee and the decision of such committee will be final. **Protests of ineligible players must be made by the opposing coach before the end of the game. If a player is deemed ineligible, that player will be removed from the game and will not be allowed to participate in the rest of the tournament.**

ELIGIBILITY: Age as of **January 1, 2009**

PROOF OF AGE: Birth certificate, baptismal certificate or hospital certificate may be used. Tournament Committee decision on any document is final. Head Coach is responsible for providing documentation on site if requested by Tournament Director or Protest Committee member.

REFUNDS: If a team cancels, all but \$50.00 of the entry fee will be returned, IF Oklahoma State IFA is notified before July 10, 2009. After that date there will be **NO** refunds.

ADMISSION: Passes for the tournament will be sold at the park and during registration. The cost will be:

- ROSTERS:** Enclosed in the packet is an Official Roster. **Please complete and return with tournament registration form and entry fee.**
- COACH'S MEETING/
LUNCHEON:** The Coach's meeting will be held Monday, July 20, 2009 from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. at the host hotel, Holiday Inn. All questions regarding rules and tournament play will be answered.
- GIFTS:** There will be a gift exchange between your team and another team from a different area. Gifts should be inexpensive souvenirs that relate to the area you are from or your team name. The gift exchange will take place AFTER the first pool game.
- FOOD &
DRINKS:** NO food or drinks may be brought into Wildhorse Park. Concessions are available.
EXCEPTION: Teams may bring 1 team cooler, which must have a cooler tournament pass. Each dugout will also be provided with a water cooler of ice water.
- PHOTOGRAPHER:** A photographer will be available at the park for team, individual and action photos.
